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1.0 Introduction

Good Morning Ladies and Gentlemen.

On behalf of the staff and students of Rane Vidyalaya, I take immense pleasure in welcoming this august gathering, to the **Fourth Annual Day Celebrations**, a significant landmark in the journey of the Institution. I am extremely privileged and honored to welcome our Chief Guest Mr.R.Venkatanarayanan President, Rane Corporate Services, Chennai and Mr.D.Viswanathan, Advisor, Rane Foundation, Mr.N.Venkateswaran, Sr. Manager, Finance and Mrs. B.Rajalakshmi, Correspondent, Rane Vidyalaya. I also welcome my beloved colleagues, students, parents and other distinguished guests.

2.0 Rane Group

Rane's CSR Vision is "to be a socially and environmentally responsible corporate citizen". The endeavour of the group is to channelize efforts towards addressing key societal issues. Rane Vidyalaya was established in June 2018 at Trichy with a mission of providing quality education for rural children. The school began functioning from the academic year 2018-19 with 66 students and I am proud to say that we have crossed the 500 mark last week in the fourth year of operations amidst the pandemic.



3.0 Academic Highlights:

The school got its AFFILIATION from CBSE in the month of April-2020 amidst lockdown. We are very proud to state that we are one of the first schools to have achieved this in a short period of time.

We have started the academic year 2021-22 in 5th April 2021 through online. Our Students strength has seen a steady increase from 66 in the first year, 225 in the second year, 360 in the third year to 459 in 2021-22 with 21 teachers and 10 Office Staff.

We were one of the first school to adapt to online classes from Apr 2020 itself. Our teachers worked round the clock in

- a) Adapting the curriculum to online classes
- b) Learning technology like Zoom, Google Meet, Classrooms and making videos
- c) Teaching the parents and the children to adapt to online methods
- d) Ensure that the learning loss is minimized to the maximum extent through individual attention.

We are therefore proud to proclaim that we were able to achieve most of the goals that we set for ourselves in the learning outcomes at the Foundational Literacy level. While all around we found students struggling with learning losses, Rane Vidyalaya has been able to get on to its feet with the resumption of classes in the school.

We did not miss any club activity, cultural functions or national festivals.

We inaugurated our literary clubs online in the first week of August and had the English oratorical competition coinciding with 15th of August, Independence Day. We were flooded with videos and photographs of the kids who participated in the English Oratorical competition.



Academics

Term-wise progress reports have been shared with the parents in the PTA meetings and we are proud to say that 70% of the students have achieved the Annual Goals set for the respective classes. The credit of the excellent performance is attributed to the hard work of the **teachers**.

Academics has been our focus. To benchmark ourselves, we encouraged our students to participate in the Science Olympiad Foundation – SOF International English and Maths Olympiad conducted by them. Our students also participated in the Green Olympiad conducted by The Energy Research Institute of India. We also participated in the All India Level Young Explorers contest conducted by IISER, Pune and DAV group of institutions.

I am proud to announce the following:

- a) SOF International English Olympiad – Two students have received Gold Medal of Excellence in their respective classes. Sivshankar K of class IV and Ananya S of Class V.

- b) TERI Green Olympiad – Gaurangi K of IV got Distinction Award and
 1. Thanushree V of IV - A
 2. Maadeshraja of IV - B
 3. Rithvik SD of VII Standard got Meritorious Performance awards.

- c) IISER Pune and DAV, Chennai conducted thru Ticklinks the Vivekananda Young Explorer contest for English, Maths and Science for children of 3 age groups – Std 1-3, 4-6 and 7-9. Students submitted projects through charts and videos. In this competition there were 8600 project submissions all over India. Two of our students have won the Excellence award and Scholarship of Rs.4,000. Thanushree of IV-A and Sanjay Darshan SA of class II-A. Two of our students



received Excellence and award and they met Top Scientist of IISER, Rithivk SD of class VII and Keerthana Mercy of Class VII.

In “Share your best” contest, one of our teacher Mrs.M.Suriya received Excellence Award and got an internship opportunity with IISER. Mrs. M.Kanimozhi, Mrs. Roseline, Mrs. Subha and Mrs. Padmapriya received cash awards and Appreciation certificates.

Our Tamil Teachers Mrs.P.Bama and C.Sundhari have been trained by Tamil Heritage Trust and we will be soon launching our Heritage Club in the school.

Tamil Nadu Illakiya Perumandaram conducted Bharathiyar Singing Competition In this Sameera of V B and Lakshitha of IV A received laurels.

In the State Level Karate Competition conducted two of our students (Jeyan of IV A and Yazhini of II B) received Prize Certificates and Medal.

State Level Karate Competition was conducted and one of our student K.N.Uganthiha won the first prize.
